Wa



This character (\mathfrak{A}) is pronounced wa.

 $\it Wa$ has several meanings, though perhaps the best way to grasp the overall concept is to imagine an atmosphere in which a group of people can comfortably and amiably coexist. The word also carries connotations of maintaining harmony and getting along with each other. The character is included in the word $\it heiwa$ (平和), which means "peace." The original meaning conveys the sense of a group working together peacefully and helping one another.

The character wa is also used to refer to Japan and Japanese people and culture. For example, in the term washoku (和食), shoku means "cuisine," giving this compound the meaning "Japanese cuisine."

Wa is tremendously valued by the Japanese, and it is a word that directly expresses the spirit of the Japanese people. In sharing *wa* with our friends (*tomodachi*) around the world, we hope to play a role in bringing peace to the world.
